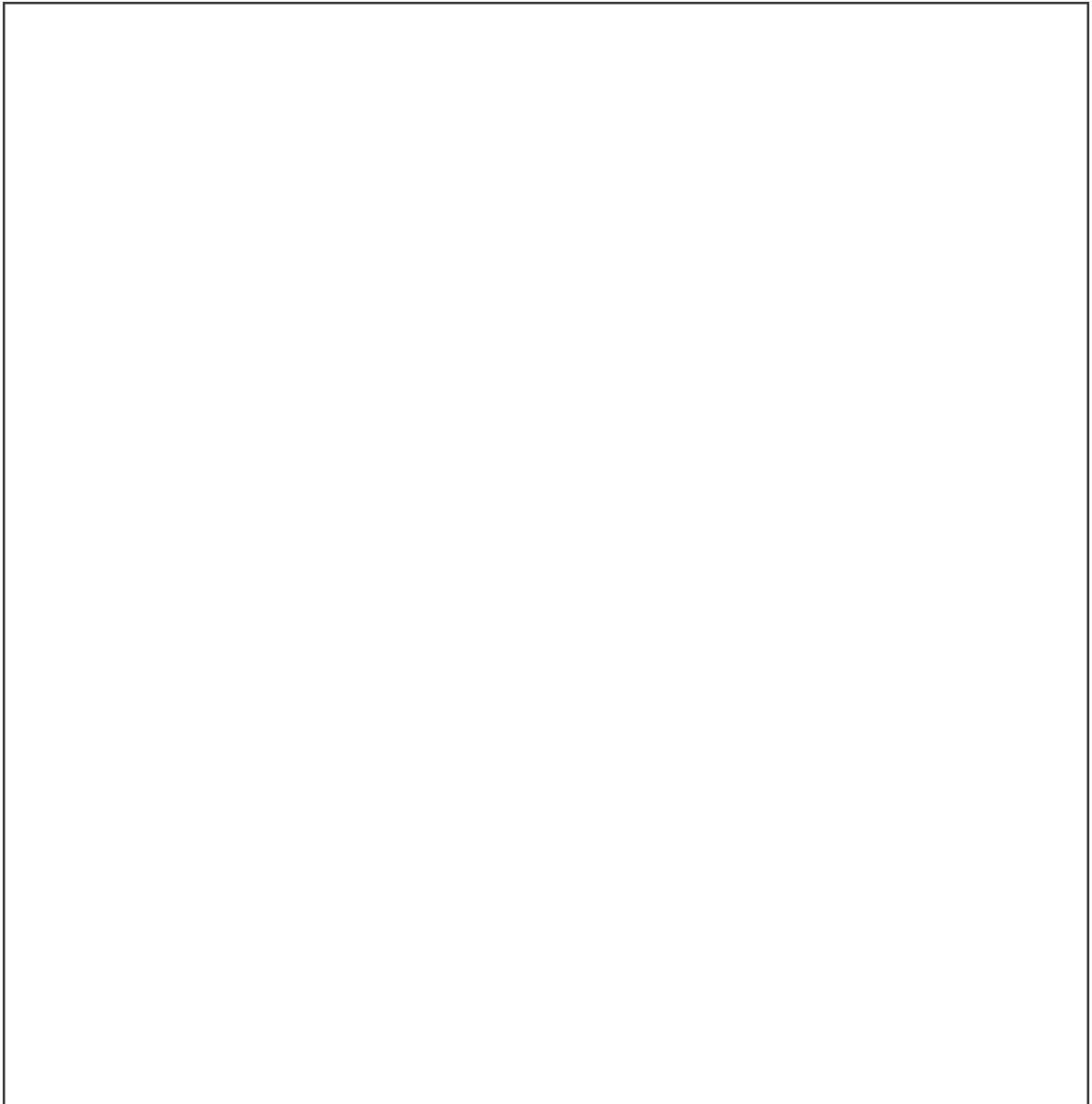

Look closely at the artwork and draw a section of it or the entire work.



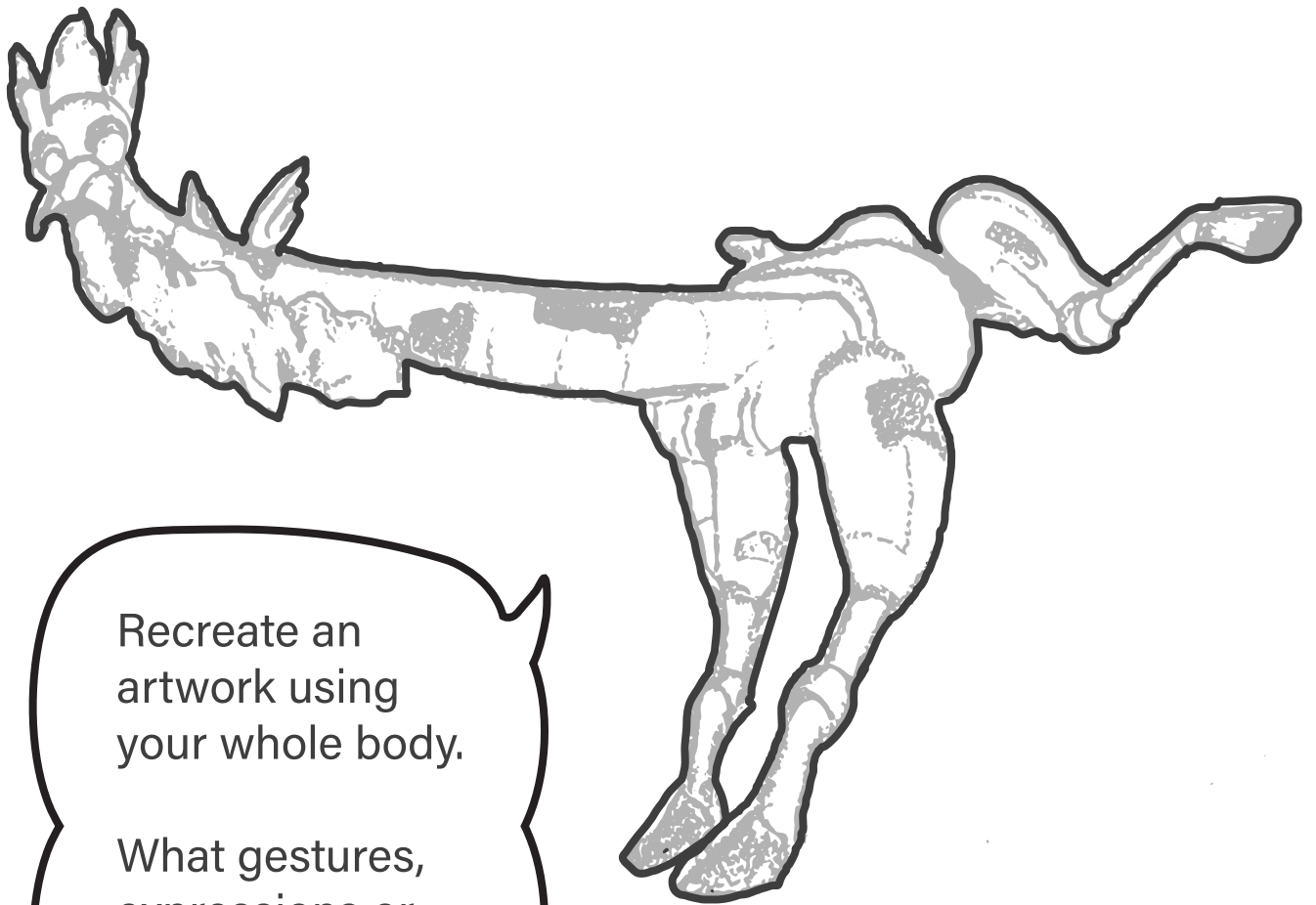
Did you notice anything new as a result of drawing it?

What did you notice?



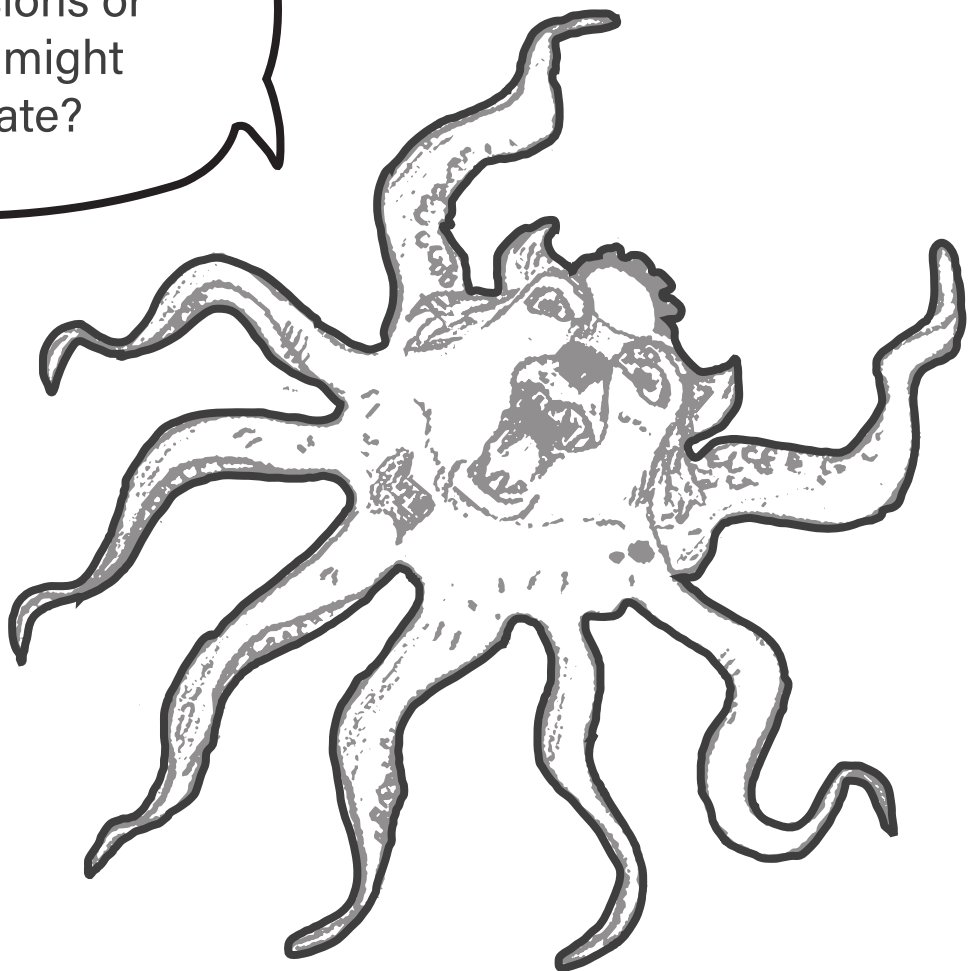
If the artist was in the room, what question(s) would you ask them?

What gestures, expressions or shapes might you create?

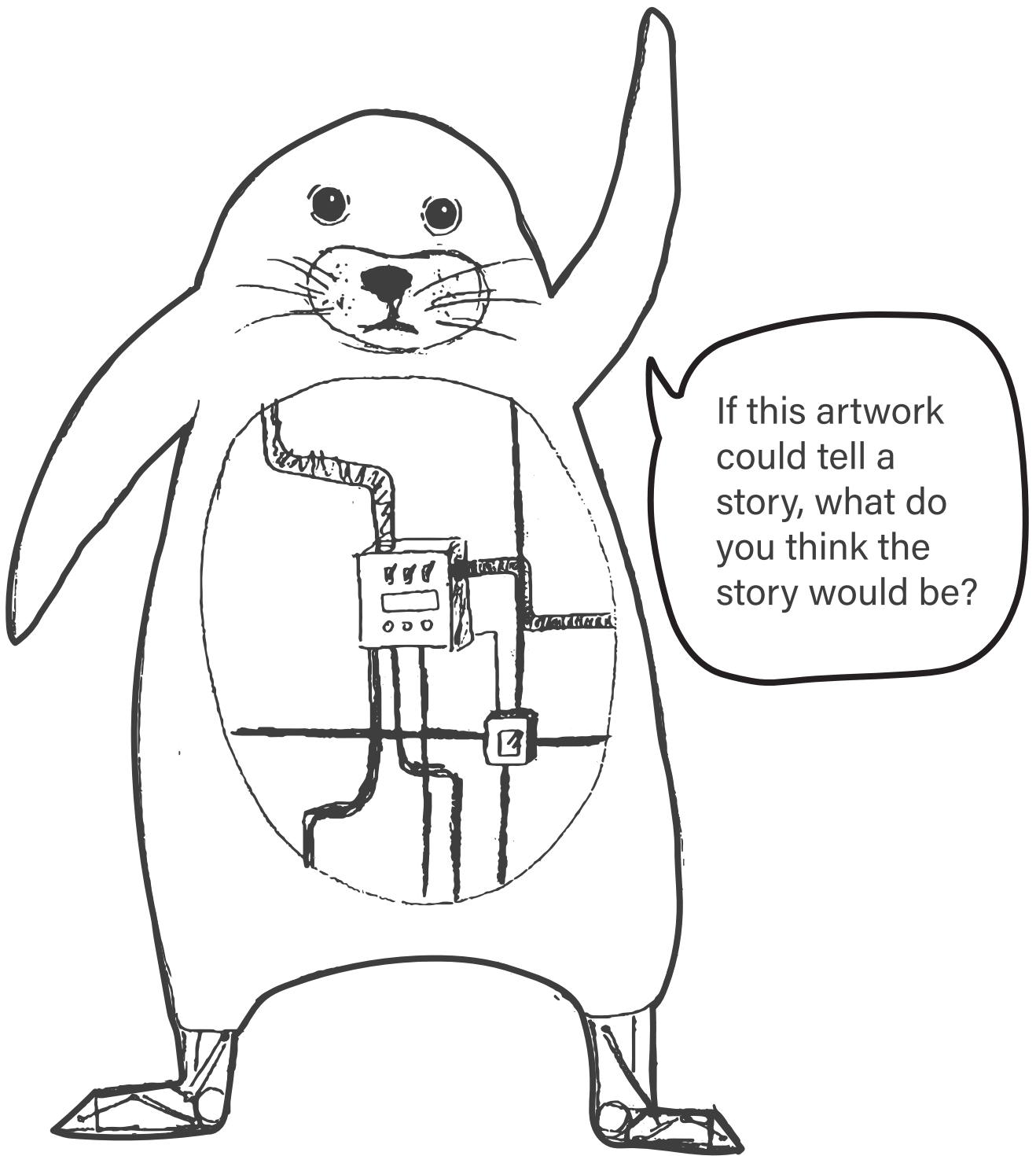




What does this artwork make you wonder about?
